Sir/ Madam,

Department of Labour, Government of West Bengal in partnership with UNICEF is going to organize a Campaign against Child Labour for promoting Child rights & Child protection from 30<sup>th</sup> April to 12<sup>th</sup> June 2022 in the state. The objective of the campaign is to accord visibility to the malaise of child labour and the violation of child rights in public discourse and encourage action across multiple levels of society towards ending child labour, bringing children back to school and connecting adolescents with skilling opportunities in non-hazardous occupations.

All the districts have been requested to plan and disseminate awareness messages on the harms of child labour and encourage people towards prevention by intervening appropriately and also to promote the rehabilitation of those rescued from labour. The dissemination is to be planned through various outdoor, mid-media and mass media channels using posters, leaflets, hoardings, cable TV/ radio spots etc. and using various platforms including that of *Duare Sarkar*. The standard communication materials for dissemination will be sent to the districts soon and the district may use funding as available at their end to implement the same. The Deputy Labour Commissioner (DLC) will be the District Nodal Officer for this campaign in their respective district, supported by other officials drawn from relevant Departments viz.

Social Welfare, School Education, Technical Education, Panchayats & Rural Development etc.

To augment the campaign aimed at creating greater awareness, three cluster level consultations in four locations across the state are proposed which will aim at securing multisectoral commitment for follow-up actions, culminating in the State level consultation in Kolkata. The five Consultations which are to be organized, with technical and financial support of UNICEF are to be held as follows:

- a. Consultation in **Siliguri** includes representation from districts of Darjeeling, Kalimpong, Alipurduar, Cooch Behar and Jalpaiguri (5 districts)
- b. Consultation in Malda will include districts of Malda, Murshidabad, Uttar Dinajpur, Dakshin Dinajpur (4 districts)
- c. Consultation in **Kharagpur** will include districts of Bankura, Paschim Medinipur, Purba Medinipur, and Jhargram (4 districts)
- d. Consultation in Asansol will include districts of Purba Barddhaman, Paschim Barddhaman, Birbhum and Purulia (4 districts).
- e. State Level Consultaion in Kolkata will include Kolkata, North 24 Parganas, South 24 Parganas, Howrah, Hooghly and Nadia (6 districts)

For these consultations, the relevant officials from line departments are invited from all districts, members of PRIs, SHGs, local NGOs and child/adolescent representatives from the host district can participate. A suggestive agenda will be shared with you.

For 12 districts (viz. Alipurduar, Jalpaiguri, Malda, Murshidabad, Dakshin Dinajpur, South 24 Parganas, Kolkata, Howrah, Paschim Medinipur, Purba Bardhaman, Purulia and Nadia) technical support may be sought from the District and Block Coordinators placed by UNICEF supported implementing partners Action Aid Association & CRY.

You are requested to advise relevant officials & sections of society under your jurisdiction to cooperate and participate.

Smt. Shaon Sen, WBCS(Executive), Additional Secretary, Labour Department, Govt. of West Bengal is the Nodal Officer for this campaign.

A video conference will be organized shortly to follow up on the plans and address any issues.
